The Magical Marimba!

"Ms. M, Ms. M, I can't wait to join the marimba band." These words were eagerly spoken by a Grade 2 pupil every time she saw me walking in the corridors. It filled my heart with joy, but also a touch of sadness, knowing that not all the school children longing to join the band would have the opportunity, as the marimba program is initially only available from Grade 6 onwards. The demand was, and continues to be incredibly high. Despite these challenges, our marimba program has blossomed from a single band of 16 girls into six bands, with just over 120 primary and high school girls who gather each week for rehearsals in their respective bands.

There is an undeniable magic to the marimba. From the sound it produces to the bonds it forges among players, this instrument has the power to create everlasting relationships and foster teamwork. It is an instrument that every soul should have the chance to play and experience.

In 2015, our first marimba band was created, and the girls have taken delight in sharing their music with others. We perform at various school functions, shopping malls, carnivals, churches, competitions in KZN and Gauteng, outdoor expos, festivals, and even at weddings. One of the highlights is witnessing the girls involve the audience, teaching them a thing or two during their performances.

I firmly believe that every human being should be afforded the opportunity to encounter and play the marimba at some point in their lifetime. In line with this belief, we have offered engaging marimba workshops, including staff development sessions, parent fun workshops, sessions for principals across KZN, and Christmas dinners for staff, boarders and students around the community. The joy expressed by everyone who engages with this instrument is truly something remarkable.

Each year, we eagerly anticipate the international marimba and steelpan festivals. Our first attendance in 2016 was an unforgettable experience. The girls enjoyed the opportunity to meet other players, learn from them, and perform at such a prestigious event. A treasured memory was during the prize-giving ceremony when our school was called out for first position in one of the categories. Initially doubting if they were referring to us, we looked at each other puzzled, as we kept getting called, until one of the girls hurried up to collect our prize. It was a moment that truly boosted our spirits and confidence in our playing.

Lastly, in a world where the digital realm thrives, and many individuals still feel isolated, let us remember that we possess a powerful tool that can help change this. With this beautiful and magical instrument, we can bring children, parents, teachers, and our communities together, allowing them to experience the love and joy that arises from playing our instrument.

It is a testament to the impact of this instrument that the Grade 2 pupil who eagerly expressed her desire to join the band has now become an integral part of our Grade 10 band, even choosing music as one of her subjects. Her journey is a shining example of the transformative power of this magical instrument - the marimba!
