Note Tuning

Note tuning, like piano tuning, is an ongoing maintenance procedure one needs to do to all models of African marimbas. Wood is a living entity and will expand in the heat and contract in the cold. If your marimbas are used regularly and exposed to various elements your notes will eventually need to be tuned. We recommend that our clients get their notes retuned around once a year depending on how often they are used. Marimba is offered as part of our cultural offering here at Beaulieu Preparatory School, alongside other music group activities such as drum-line, choir and string ensemble.

Marimba has been offered for over twenty years here at Beaulieu Preparatory and it has always remained a popular choice for our children to fulfil their cultural portfolios.

The music we learn is largely based on some of our students' favourite pop songs or is inspired by African repertoire. We keep the parts simple and learn everything aurally which means that tunes are learnt quickly, boosting both confidence and enthusiasm. Currently we run two groups but the children enjoy it so much that sometimes children join multiple groups. Collaboration with other groups is also not uncommon.

Our children perform regularly at Eisteddfods, Assemblies, Open Days and took part in the Virtual International Marimba and Steelpan Festival in 2022.
